Essential Duties and Functions

Essential duties and functions, pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act, may include the following

- Warmly welcome guests to the Zilker Botanical Garden
- Accurately record and process Garden admissions
- Answer questions from guests
- Responsible for opening the admissions booth and entry gate at the start of the day and closing, securing at the end of the day
- Demonstrate regular and punctual attendance
- Must be available 15-25 hours per week with weekend availability
- Work outdoors in all weather conditions
- Stay informed of garden events and programs and direct guests accordingly
- Advocate for and steward the mission of the conservancy to all guests as appropriate

Requirements

- Reliable transportation and a valid driver's license or ID
- Basic knowledge of the Zilker Botanical Garden
- Ability to communicate effectively and interact cooperatively with visitors and coworkers
- Experience interacting with the public and handling questions in a professional manner

- Ability to work weekdays and weekends during garden hours. Evenings and extended hours may be required during peak times and special events.
